## CONSTITUTION.

Article 1st.—This Society shall be called "THE IN-FANT SCHOOL SOCIETY OF HALIFAX."

Article 2d.—The object of this Society shall be to establish a School, where the Infant children of the poor may be taught various branches of useful knowledge, especially to instil into their tender minds, moral and religious instruction.

Article 3rd.—This Society shall be supported by annuat subscriptions, and donations, collected by the Managers and friends of the Institution.

Article 4th.—This Society shall consist of a Patroness, Vice Patroness, Treasurer, Secretary, and a Committee of twelve married ladies, who shall each appoint two other ladies to assist them in their duties.
