- RULE 5. If a member, while speaking, be called to order, he shall take his seat until the question of order is determined, if the point of order raised be decided in his favor, he may proceed.
- Rule 6. Each member, when speaking, shall stand and respectfully address the chair, confine himself to the question under debate, and avoid all personalities or indecorous language.
- RULE 7. A motion carried in the affirmative or negative shall not be subject to reconsideration unless such action shall take place at the same or next regular meeting. Every member present entitled to vote, must exercise that right unless excused.
- RULE 8. If two or more members rise to speak at the same time, the chair shall decide which is entitled to the floor.
- RULE 9. A question shall not be subject to debate until it has been seconded and stated from the chair, and it shall be reduced in writing at the request of the chair.
- RULE 10. Before putting a question, the presiding officer shall ask: "Are you ready for the question?" If no member rise to speak, he
