Russian War Losses.

Some striking figures are published by The Novoe Vremya as to the forces at the disposal of the Russian commander-in-chief in Manchuria at the close of the late war. When peace was concluded General Linevitch had at his disposal 12,500 officers, 917,000 men and 270,000 horses. But from the beginning to the end of the war there had been carried to the front 20,000 officers, 1,270,000 men, 230,000 horses, and more than 1600 guns. Subtracting these figures, and making allowance for the 80,000 men already on the spot when war broke out the Russian losses appear roughly 7500 officers and 433,000 men.
