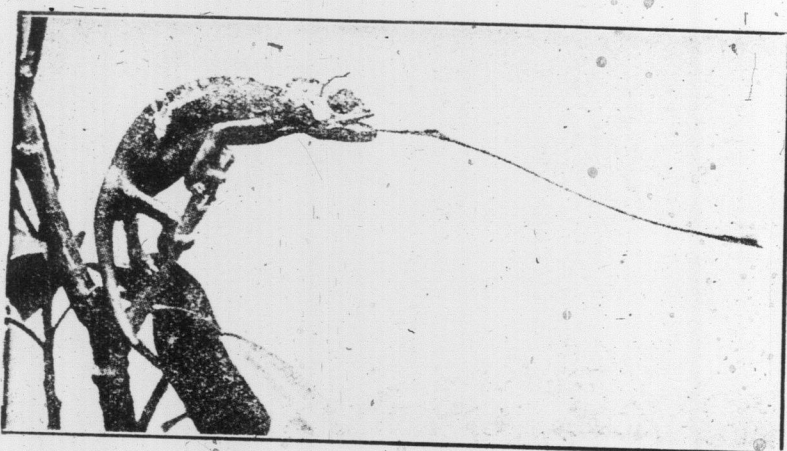

WITH A TONGUE AS LONG AS ITSELF, A CHAMELEON IN ITS NATIVE HAUNTS.



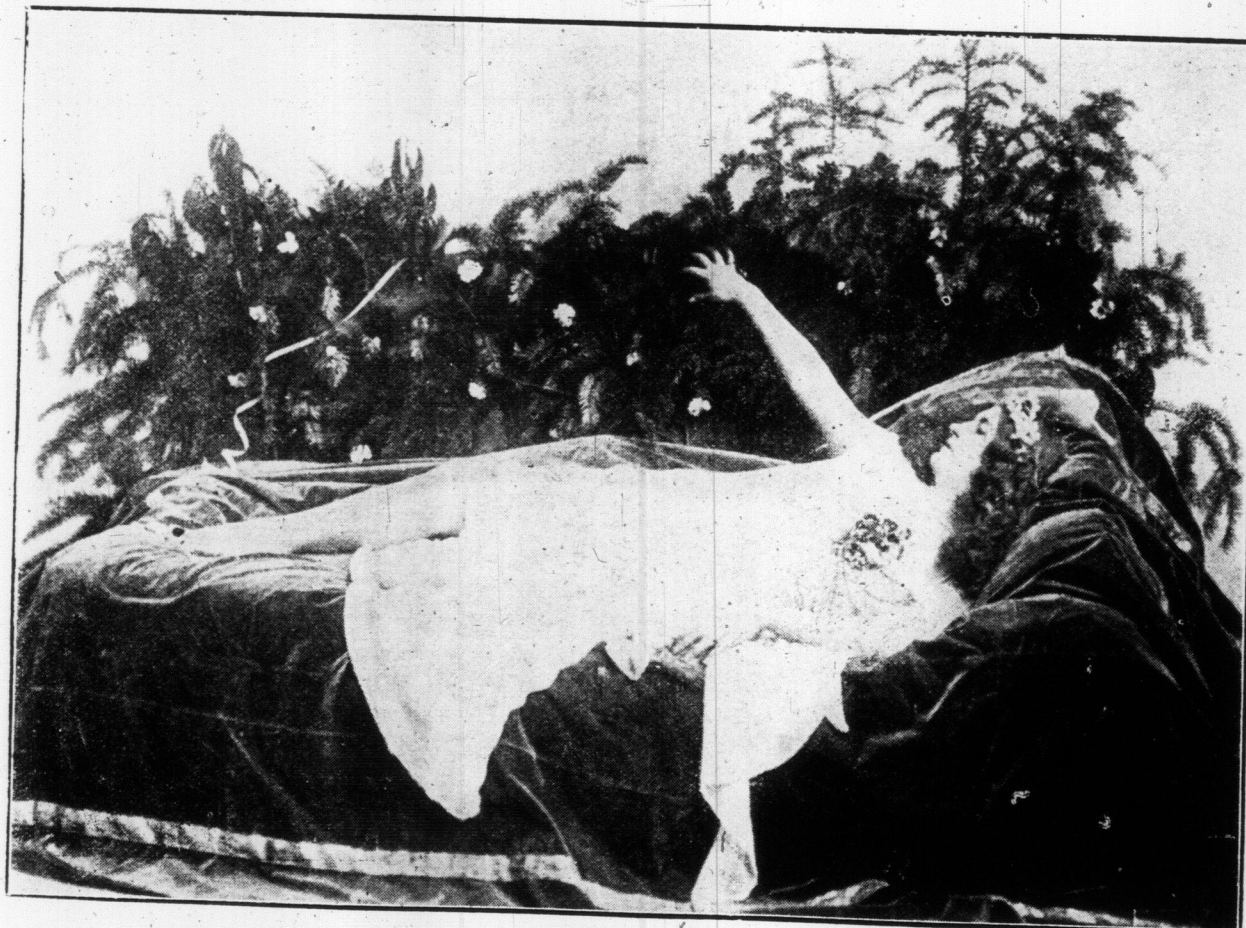

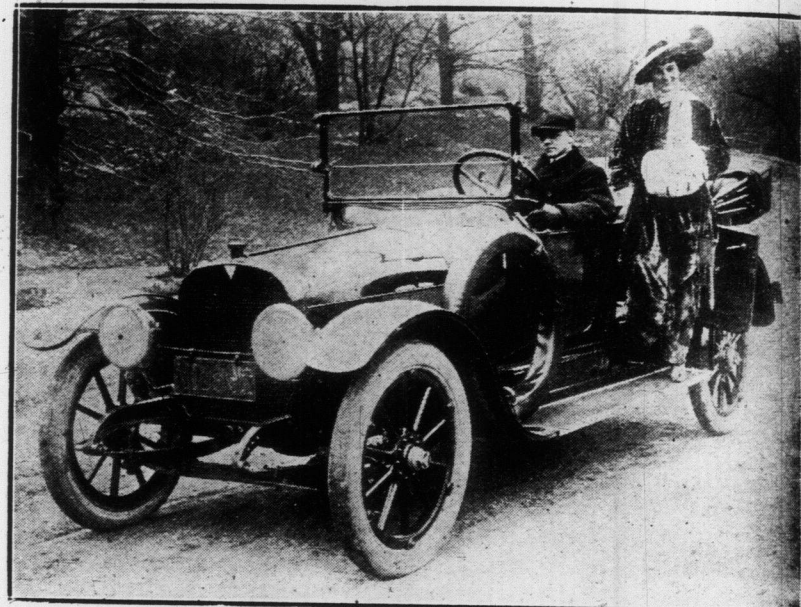
