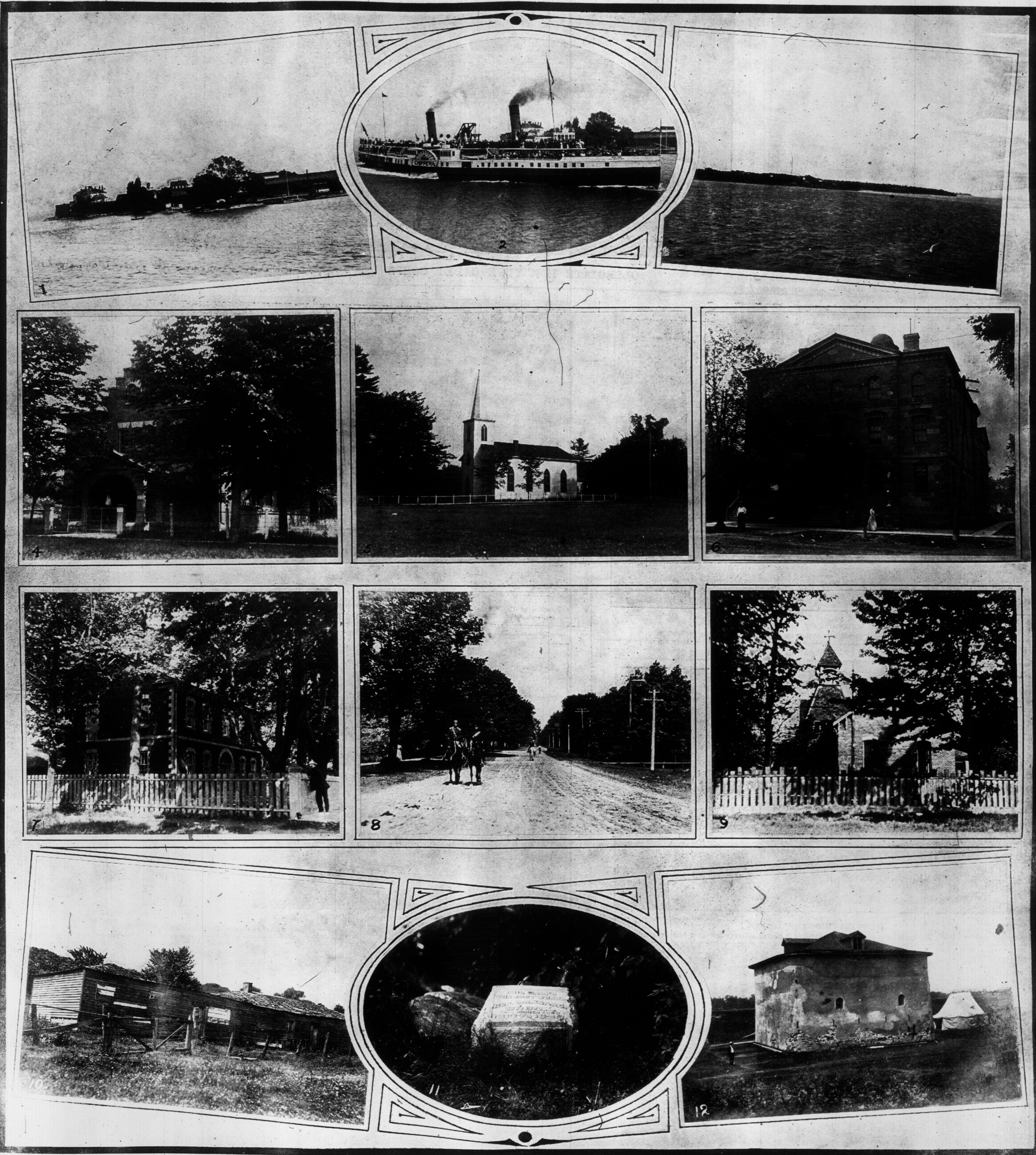


## Interesting Scenes in and About Old Historic Niagara
