were regularly assessed. They amounted to \$979.40 which included injury done to the properties of fourteen Indiana and included three hundred and seventy one dellare and sixty cente compensation for desage to a dam on break-vater. The Company duly paid the whole of the said damage.

We have an item in the estimates of \$1500.00 for dyking and irrigation in British Columbia. This sum may be drawn upon in part and perhaps the whole of it may be taken for the purpose, provided, as above stated, that a well considered scheme is placed before the Department for its consideration.
