FOREST

As Post Village and station of the Grand Trunk Rail Road, situated in the township of Plympton, 14th Con., and 30th Lot. It is distant from Sarnia 25 miles. The village was laid out in 1857, and the post office was established in 1859. First postmaster, A. M. Patton. The village is rapidly improving. It contains one saw mill, three hotels, three shops, two blacksmith shops, one wagon shop, five general stores. Mails daily per G.T.R., from the east and west. From Hillsborough tri-weekly, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturlays. Archibald Dickson, postmaster. Five hundred car loads of staves and square timber, 70 car loads of hoops, 50 car loads of wheat (27,000 bushels) were shipped at this place last summer.
