DR. HINKS PRESENTS STARTLING FIGURES

The Penalty We Pay for Failure to Care for the Feeble-Minded Addressing the Social Service Congress in Toronto, Dr. Clarence M. Hinks, secretary of the Canadian National Committee for Mental Hygiene, spoke of the tragedy resulting from the negligence of most governments the world over in dealing with the feeble-minded. Any man who had a factory for making explosives and inflammable chemicals, who saw it burned down again and again yet didn't insure it, would be considered a fool. Yet governments who are warned on good authority, which they profess to accept, that the feeble-minded are irresponsible, that they will burn buildings, become prostitutes, spread venereal disease, bear illegitimate and feeble-minded children, steal, become paupers, retard classes and poison morals in schools, and even commit murder, let the years roll round without taking any adequate action. At the psychiatric clinic at the University of Toronto, Dr. Hinks said, almost 5,000 cases of feeble-mindedness had been studied, and of this number 1,000 were found to be high-grade morons—from whose ranks are recruited murderers, thieves and prostitutes—572 imbeciles, 123 idiots and 638 insane. They had been committed by 704, by some of these ten times; 469 were chronic truants, 294 had borne illegitimate and feeble-minded children, 89 girls under 15 years of age were immoral, and 17 had been referred for acts of bodily violence, 26 for shopbreaking and 73 for setting fire to buildings. "Legislators—unless they happen to be Lloyd George," said Dr. Hinks,

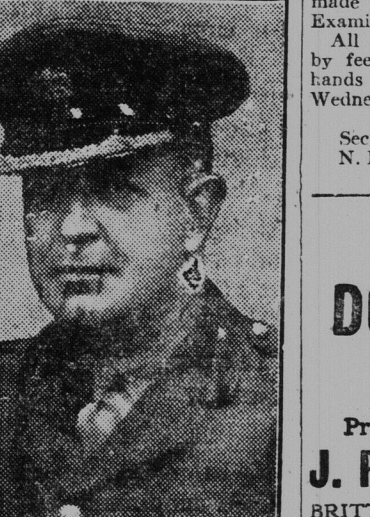
