

A CHILD who suddenly darts out from the sidewalk into the road in a game of tag, or one who jumps from behind a standing vehicle, is far more likely to be run down by a motor car than a child

The carefully kept records of the Toronto Police Department shows that out of a total of 2,173 accidents of various kinds in 1923, cyclists were only involved in 42, and 36 of these were cases of collis-tions of cyclists and pedestrians.
