The Synod met, and was constituted by the Rev. Mr. Ormiston, Moderator.

Read and received an Overture from the Rev. Dr. Ferrier, transmitted by the Flamboro' Presbytery, setting forth the propriety and desirableness of observing in this country the Tri-centenary of the Reformation in Scotland, now approaching; and suggesting the appointment of a Committee to make all necessary arrangements for celebrating in a suitable manner the three-hundredth anniversary of so glorious an event.

It was agreed that in accordance with the recommendations of the Overture, the Synod resolve to spend the evening of Wednesday at its next regular meeting, in devotional exercises, accompanied with appropriate addresses; and appoint a Committee to make arrangements for this meeting, and to co-operate with Committees appointed by other Churches in making any other arrangements by which the Tri-centenary of the Reformation may be most suitably celebrated.
