1. Herewith enclosed proceedings on the marginally-noted trial by District Court-Martial, the finding and sentence having been confirmed by the District Officer Commanding, and duly promulgated.
2. Also enclosed is MFM.288 duly completed.
3. The same are forwarded to your office for registration and custody.
4. Gnr. MacDonald was found "guilty" of all the charges and sentenced to 2 years Detention with Stoppages of \$25.91.
5. It will be noted that this soldier was 57 days in custody and the following is day-by-day description of the action:-

11 Sept 41	Accused apprehended.
16 " "	Accused confined at No. 3A District Depot and placed in hospital.
8 Oct. "	Accused escaped from hospital.
15 Mar. 44	Accused apprehended.
19 " "	Accused confined at No. 3A District Depot.
20 " "	Wired for documents.
22 " "	Documents received; telephoned District Headquarters for MFM.215 and extracts Part II Orders.
26 " "	MFM.215 received.
3 Apr. "	Telephoned District regarding extracts Part II Orders.
5 " "	Telephoned re Part II Orders and advised to proceed on MPB.375 which omitted hour of absence.
6 " "	Application for trial forwarded to District Headquarters.
12 " "	Trial held.
