1880. At the annual communication of Grand Lodge, June, 1879, he was elected Grand Director of Ceremonies and appointed a member of the Board of General Purposes, which position he occupied at the time of his death. Cut down in the prime of his manhood, Brother McNeill was a respected and useful citizen, and a most exemplary and worthy mason.
