An Act to Incorporate "The Canada Life Assurance Company."

WHEREAS Hugh Cossart Baker, John Preamble. Young, Sir Allan N. MacNab, James Bell Ewart, Richard O. Duggan, Daniel C. Gunn, John O. Hatt, Archibald Kerr, The 5 Honourable Malcolm Cameron, William P. McLaren, Daniel McNab, Nehemiah Merritt, Miles O'Reilly, James Osborne, Richard P. Street, Edward Cartwright, Thomas and George S. Tiffany of the City of Hamilton, 10 The Honourable Adam Ferguson of Woodhill, John Wetenhall of Nelson, and The Honourable George Strange Boulton of Esquires, the President, Vice-Cobourg, President and Directors of "The Canada 15 Life Assurance Company," by their humble petition in this behalf, have represented that a number of the citizens of the City of Hamilton, and other residents of Canada, have associated themselves together for the pur-20 pose of prosecuting the business of Life Assurance in its various branches, within this Province, under the name of "The Canada Life Assurance Company," under a certain Deed of Settlement by which the 25 Capital Stock of the said Association is limited to the sum of fifty thousand pounds of lawful money of Canada, divided into five hundred shares of one hundred pounds each, the whole of which have been subscribed 30 and taken up, and have since the formation of the said Association, on the 21st day of August one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven, accepted risks, and issued Policies of Assurance to a very large 35 amount, and still continue to do so, and have, in accordance with the provisions of the said Deed of Settlement, prayed that for the bet-
