## Mississauga council opposes rent controls

Rent-control legislation is opposed by Mississauga council.

Council has refused to endorse a Brampton resolution calling on the Ontario government to consider the possibility of rent-control legislation.

The resolution stated that rent increases are often exorbitant and that the long-range affect may be greater pressure on subsidized housing as tenants are forced to find alternative accommodation.

Mayor Martin Dobkin strongly opposed any form of rent control on grounds it inevitably backfires and

leads to the growth of slums. Citing New York City as an example, Dobkin said rent controls reduce the profit incentive and this in turn cuts back housing development.

He noted Mississauga is working on a comprehensive housing policy and that this city is providing the Toronto area with much of its rental-housing stock.

Dobkin said that if other communities in the Toronto

area had done as much as Mississauga, the rental-shortage problem would not exist.

The long-range answer, according to Dobkin, lies in increasing the supply of rental housing through increased government subsidies.

## Yule tree: put it to work

Instead of throwing your Christmas tree into the garbage, this time, put it into the garden.

A few branches, cut and laid on the ground to form a mulch, will protect roses, strawberries, chrysanthemums and other special plants.

The branches trap snow and snow is one of the best insulators.

Snow forms an even cover and, of course, costs nothing. Mulches prevent the freezing and thawing which heaves the roots and damages plants.

Evergreen needles and finely cut branches could be dug into the garden next spring to improve the soil texture.

Flowering bulbs in pots can be rooted outdoors in trenches, for later indoor

forcing, if the soil in the trench is protected by thick layers of Christmas-tree boughs.

In addition, discarded trees make excellent bird shelters and feeding stations.
