

## Youth up for sentencing

BRAMPTON — A Mississauga juvenile convicted of possessing marijuana will appear Feb. 5 in family court in Brampton for sentencing.

The youth was originally scheduled to appear before Magistrate H. T. G. Andrews Jan. 15, but this appearance was cancelled because of that weekend's snow and ice storm.

He was convicted Dec.

14 but his sentencing was delayed until the magistrate received a presentence report.

The youth was one of four teen-agers arrested during a roundup by Streetsville police and RCMP drug squad investigators last October.

Two juvenile girls who appeared earlier were ordered to stay out of Yorkville and post peace bonds.

(Cont. from Page 1) Brakes were useless on most side streets.

Hydro lines which gave way beneath their coating of ice left Streetsville without power for about an hour Monday afternoon. But repairs were completed before any

real hardship had been caused. Telephone service was also disrupted briefly.

Mr. King, the man killed on Derry rd., was 29.

The accident occurred shortly after 9 a.m. at the intersection of Derry rd. and Dixie rd. on Derry rd. just west of Malton.

Mr. King, who is married, was on his way to work. He was alone in his car when the collision occurred in thick fog.

The truck, which was travelling in the same direction as Mr. King's vehicle, was being driven

by Walter Kooy (48) of Landour ave. Toronto. He was uninjured.

The Malton man's car was completely wrecked by the force of the impact and it took several minutes for police to extricate the dead man's body.
