

York Upper Canada
8th Augt 1817.

Sir

Two of the Guard were in charge
of the wreck of the *Grants* at Sebastes
Point have brought over to me this
morning a blanket containing
several pieces of cotton which
they received from some person there
also some copper hoops they put
up themselves all of which are
now at the Garrison ordnance Room
and no doubt they are part of
the Indian goods - If you will
be so good as to order some of
the Department to come and
identify them and take them
away I will thank you and if
it is in the power of the Indian
Department to make any allowance
of salvage to the Guard it might
be attended with advantage
