By-Law No. 68

A By-Law of the Municipality of Coldwell restraining animals from running at large within the Townsite of Lundar.

The Reeve and Council of the Rural Municipality of Coldwell enact as follows:—

That the following animals shall not be allowed to run at large within the surveyed Townsite of Lundar, between the hours of 7 P.M. and 7 A.M.: Horses, Mules and Cattle. (Sheel, Pigs and Goats are never allowed to run at large).

If any of the aforesaid animals, not permitted to run at large, in the said Townsite of Lundar, are found to be running at large, it shall be the duty of the Poundkeeper on demand to receive and impound such animals, and all such impounded animals shall be dealt with as provided in By-Law No. 16, relating to Pounds and Poundkeepers therefor.

Done and passed in council assembeld at Lundar in the Province of Manitoba this 5th day of August A.D., 1916.
