 Indian Agent for that Reserve;
 and further to appoint you
 Indian Lands Agent at Sarnia
 for the sale of lands belonging
 to the Sarnia Band, and for
 the collection of moneys due
 on the lands sold but not
 yet paid for, and that you
 be paid for your services by
 a commission of 5% on your
 collections, and that you give
 security, yourself in \$5,000⁰⁰
 and two sureties in \$2,500⁰⁰
 each.
