are concerned, throughout the British
Columbia, and your salary will
be payable from the date upon which
you enter upon the discharge of your
duties as Visiting Indian Supt.

Be good enough to submit to the
Department the names of two parties
willing and able to become your
sureties in the amount required; and
if they are approved of, a form of Bond
will be sent you for execution by yourself
and them; and subsequently after the
receipt of the Bond duly executed,
instructions will be sent you with regard
to the duties of your office.
