
Ottawa 20th January 1902-

Reverend Sister-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 12th Instant, requesting permission to take timber required for General Hospital at Maniwaki from the Indian Reserve at that place, and in reply to inform you that the consent of the Indians by way of Resolution of the Band should be obtained, and in order that this may be done intelligently, the Department should be furnished with a specification showing the quantities, kinds and value of timber required.

On receipt of this information, such action will be taken in the matter as may then be determined upon.
