



Ottawa, 23rd March, 1905.

Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 18th instant and previous correspondence regarding Celia Petonequod, formerly of the Chippewa Band of Saugeen, I beg to inform you that this woman who has been married to Adam Halfday, a member of the Chippewa Band of the Thames, has now become a member of the Band to which her husband belongs and is no longer eligible to receive a share of the interest moneys of the Saugeen Band. It appears that she was married to Halfday in 1891 and that you have paid her one share of interest money for September quarter 1902. Steps will be taken to refund this amount to the Band to which she formerly belonged.
