In reply to your letter of the 25th instant, respecting the stallion required for the Assiniboine Reserve, I beg to say that the Department will pay what is considered a fair and just price for a suitable horse for the purpose required on a cash basis. For a small sized Clydesdale stallion, three years of age and registered, the Department will not pay more than \$800.00 as such animals can be bought from breeders and importers in Saskatchewan at that figure. The pedigree will be required.
