



Ottawa, 10th November, 1913.

Sir,-

With reference to your trip into Treaty 9 and particularly with regard to that portion of your report in which you deal with the requirements in the way of seed of the Osnaburg Band and the Band at Martens Falls, I have to request that you will make a definite recommendation to the Department, stating when and in what manner you would recommend the purchase of seed for these Indians. Would you consider it would be well to procure the seed in Winnipeg in the Spring and request the Hudson's Bay Company to make delivery? When submitting your report with regard to the requirements of each of the Bands named in the way of seed, you should also give an estimate of cost. The Department is writing to you today with regard to the subject of implements for the above mentioned Indians.
