
Ottawa, 30th July, 1918.

With reference to your letter of the 25th instant, I beg to say that you may inform J.G. Morton & Son that they may continue supplies to Newell Paul to the amount of \$10.00 a month.

If it is necessary to increase this amount during the winter months, you may authorize \$15.00 a month, but if there are other merchants in Milton who are in a position to supply this Indian, you should secure prices from them and give the order to the firm quoting the lowest prices. Messrs. Morton's accounts should be forwarded promptly to the Department for payment.
