by the Board, may adjourn the meeting to such time and place as he has been instructed by the Board to adjourn it. If no such instructions have been received, the Water Recorder shall adjourn the meeting from day to day.

(6.) No special or particular form shall be necessary in the F conduct of proceedings antecedent to the hearing, or before the Board, or in the conduct or management of the Board's business.

Filing Claims.

294. (1.) No particular form shall be necessary to bring on any statement of claim claim before the Board. It shall be sufficient if the claimant files with the Board a statement of claim in writing in respect of each record, setting out-

(a.) An exact copy of the record claimed or the reason why such copy is not given:

(b.) A description of the particular land to which it is claimed the record is appurtenant:

(c.) A sketch showing the position of the point of diversion and the dams, ditches, and flumes to the claimant's land:
(d.) The character and brief description of the works:

The purpose for which the water has been or is to be used:

(f.) The title to the land held by the grantee at the date of the record, including the date of pre-emption record or permission to purchase from the Crown:

(g.) The title of the claimant to the land to which the record or the right claimed is appurtenant:

(h.) The irrigable and the irrigated area of such land:

- (i.) The quantity of water glaimed, expressed in miners' inches, cubic feet per second, gallons per day, or acre-feet per annum:
- (j.) The date when the water was first put to a beneficial use. (2.) Any number of persons claiming under one record may unite in a statement of claim.
- (3.) If the right claimed is not appurtenant to any particular land, mine, or undertaking, the claimant shall set out the chain of title from the original grantee.

295. (1.) At any time after the passing of this Act, the Board Claims under Rivers and may publish for six months in the Gazette a notice calling upon seach and every holder of an authority under the "Rivers and Streams Act" to file a statement of claim. Such notice shall set out a list of all such holders so far as known to the Board, and shall state that, if statements of claim are not filed before the expiration of six months from the date of such notice, such authority shall be cancelled and that objections to the confirmation of any such authority may be filed with the Comptroller.

(2.) The Board shall send by registered letter to each and every holder of such authority whose address is known a copy of the said notice and a form of statement of claim.
