I do not pretend for a moment that these increases are all unjustifiable. On the contrary, I regard some of them at least as entirely justifiable; indeed I should be glad to see the increase larger in some cases. I should be glad to see a larger increase for the lighthouse and coast service, for I think that if there is a department of the public service which has been neglected more than another during the past six years It is this one. I should be glad also to see a greater increase in the expenditure for the government of the North-west Territorles. Judging by the accounts I heard of the inadequacy of the public revenues as reduction of debt is concerned, if we

for the purposes of the country during my recent trip to the west, I think that the grant that is made for this service might very well have been supplemented. But I bring this table before the House because I think it is right that the House and the country should know to what extent the various departments of the public service have increased the public expenditure during these growing times.

As to the public debt, my hon, friend the Minister of Finance has dealt with that very fully in his speech. It is quite true that he shows a very good record so far
