SECTION XXXVI.

A motion to adjourn simply shall always be in order, except—

(1) In interruption of a member speaking;

(2) When members are voting;

(3) When an adjournment was the last preceding motion;

(4) When it has been decided that the previous question shall be put.

SECTION XXXVII.

The previous question shall be put in this form: "Shall the main question be now put?" If this is carried, no further motions or amendments or debate shall be permitted; but the main question shall be put without delay.

SECTION XXXVIII.

Except when voting is by ballot, the Chairman shall be entitled to vote only on an equality of votes, in which case he shall have the casting vote.

SECTION XXXIX.

The yeas and nays upon any question shall be recorded in the Minutes, when called for by three members.

SECTION XL.

This Constitution may be amended or added to at any regular meeting, provided notice in writing shall have been given at least two weeks previously.
