## OCCULATIONS.

There will be eight occulations of Planets by the Moon during the year named, six of Saturn, January 28th, April 19th, May 16th, June 12th, September 3rd, and October 1st, one of Venus March 9th. None of these will be visible at Charlottetown, occurring in the day time or when the Moon is below the horizon. One of Mars will occur December 6th, at 11 minutes past 6 in the evening, but this in our latitude will only appear as a near approach, the Moon passing about one-sixth of its diameter to the south of the planet.
