been pleafed to entertain of me, and the affurance of my earnest defire to merit a continuance of it.

A Meffage from His Excellency the Governor in Chief, figned by His Excellency, was preferred by the Honorable Mr. Irvine, to Mr. Speaker, which meffage was read, all the Members being uncovered, and the fame is as followeth, videlicet :

The Declaration of War, lately made by the the United States of America againft Great Britain and its dependencies, having placed this Province in a flate of immediate and increasing danger, it becomes a matter of imperious necessity to provide for the public fasty, by arming the government with the amplest powers and authorities for promptly suppressing any attempt to produce diforder or insubordination, and for the immediate punishment of whatever offences may interrupt or endanger the public tranquility.

Under these circumstances, the Governor in Chief would have felt himself fully justified, in exercising the power vested in him by His Majesty, of making a general and unqualified declaration of Martial Law in the Province, as soon as it was officially known that war had been declared by America, and that the country was threatened by an immediate invasion; but he has been restrained from this measure, by the confideration that as the Legislature were shortly to assemble, he might confidently rely upon their loyalty and wisdom, for supplying him with fuch powers for the above purposes, as should without interfering with the ordinary Jurisdiction of the Civil Courts, enable him upon all occasions, when he should fee fit, to proceed summarily against offenders of every description.

The Governor in Chief, therefore, fubmits to the confideration of the Houte of Affembly, the neceffity of immediately itrengthening the hands of His Majetty's Government, by arming him with this indifpenfible authority, which he trufts, they will have the lefs hefitation in doing, from their conviction that he can, at all times, by virtue of his commifion
