Message, from his Excellency the Governor requiring the attendance of the House of Assembly in the council chamber.

Mr. Speaker with the House having attended, his Excellency was pleased to give his assent to the following bills:—Viz.

Bills assented.

To “ An act for the better ascertaining and confirming the boundaries of the several counties within this province, and for subdividing them into towns and parishes.”

“ An act for the appointment of town or parish officers in the several counties in this province.”

“ An act for assessing, collecting and levying county rates.”

“ An act to enable the treasurers of the respective counties in this province, to recover from such person or persons as have heretofore received any monies or are otherwise indebted for the sale of mill privileges and public lots.”

“ An act for establishing a tender in all payments to be made in this province.”

“ An act against forestallers and regrators.”

“ An act to regulate and provide for the support of the poor in this province.”

“ An act for preventing trespasses.”

“ An act to prevent nuisances by hedges, weares, feins and other incumbrances obstructing the passage of fish in the rivers, coves and creeks in this province.”

“ An act for regulating innholders, tavern-keepers and retailers of spirituous liquors.”

“ An act for preventing idleness and disorders and for punishing rogues, vagabonds and other idle and disorderly persons.”

“ An act to enable the corporation of the city of *Saint John* to raise a sum of money, not exceeding *three hundred* pounds in the whole, nor more than *one hundred* pounds in any *one* year, to pay off their debts already incurred and to defray the necessary contingent expences arising within the said city.”

“ An act for the better extinguishing fires that may happen within the city of *Saint John*.”

“ An act for relief against absconding debtors.”

“ An act to prevent the burning of woods, by carelessly or wantonly firing the same.”

“ An act establishing the rates to be taken for wharfage and crantage of ships and other vessels, within the limits of this province.”
