Fargo, N. D., Sept. 7.—"Justifiable, excusable, and proper," was the verdict of the coroner's jury that inquired into the shooting of Robert Williams, Industrial Worker of the World, by Northern Railway police detectives, whom Williams attempted to hold up on a moving freight train last night.

### THINKS DEMPSEY IS COMING CHAMPION

Heavyweights are not nearly so scarce as they were a few years ago. New ones have been springing up in various parts of the country, and in some cases they look very good. Jack Kearns, the San Francisco manager and promoter, thinks he has a coming champion in Jack Dempsey, formerly of Salt Lake City. Dempsey was training about the desert part of the country for a while and finally drifted to San Francisco, taking up with Kearns as manager. He has had a number of fights on the Coast, and the showing he made was enough to convince such men as Eddie Graney, and Jack Welsh, both high class referees, that he has the ability in the heavyweight class.

Kearns is all enthusiasm over his find and says: "It is not 'rot' when I tell you that I have the most sensational fighter in the country today, at least I think so, and that is the opinion of many California fight fans and sport writers. To my mind Jack Dempsey is the coming heavyweight champion. He holds that title now on the Pacific Coast, having won ten consecutive fights by the knockout route. His last two starts were against Al Norton, whom he stopped in one round, and he beat Billy Meehan in four rounds. He is only twenty two years of age and stands 6 feet 1 inch, and weighs 202 pounds in condition. Spike Kelley, who has been training him and knows a fighter when he sees one, thinks that Dempsey is the greatest piece of fighting machinery he has seen or handled since the days of Jim Corbett, Bob Fitzsimmons and Stanley Ketchel.

"Dempsey is not the mauling, bruising kind of a boxer like Carl Morris and others. He is a ring master of the Benny Leonard type and knows how to box as well as fight. He is originally from west Virginia, but the Californians have adopted him as a native son. I am ready to match him with any heavyweight in the world, and do not draw the color line. I hope to match him up with Fred Fulton, whom I consider the best heavyweight in the country today, Carl Morris, or Frank Moran. I say this, because I do not think any of them can stop Dempsey and we are willing to take a chance over any distance."

### FIFTY BUSHELS TO ACRE

Calgary, Sept. 7.—R. C. Noble, of Nobleford, Alta., has one field of wheat, 1400 acres, which will thresh out 50 bushels to the acre. He has a total wheat crop of 10,000 acres, which will yield an average of 30 bushels. They are now threshing this crop.

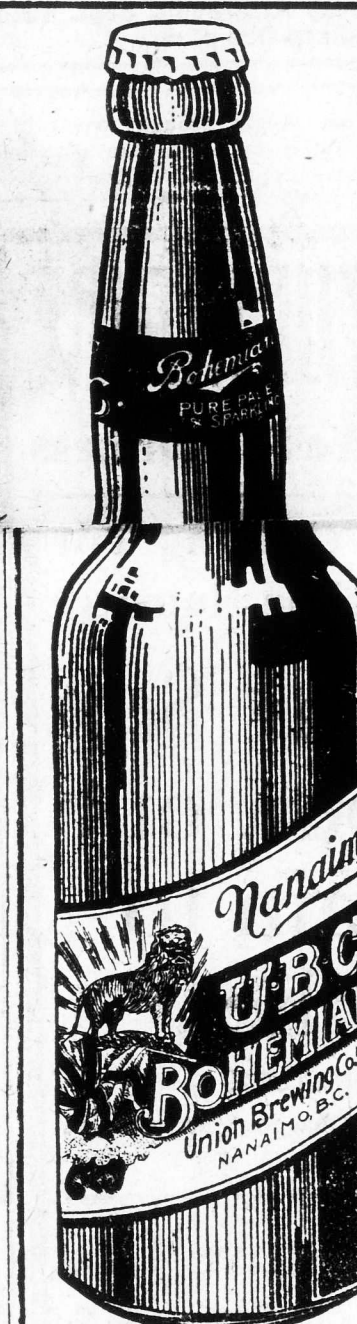
