Dempsey was roaming about the desert part of the country for a while and finally drifted to San Francisco, taking up with Kearns as manager. He has had a number of fights on the Coast, and the showing he made was enough to convince such men as Eddie Graney, and Jack Welsh, both high class referees, that he has the ability in the heavyweight class.

Kearns is all enthusiasm over his find and says: "Its is not 'rot' when I tell you that I have the most sensational fighter in the country today, at least I think so, and that is the opinion of many California fight fans and sport writers. To my mind Jack Dempsey is the coming heavyweight champion. He holds that title now on the Pacific Coast, having won ten consecutives fights by the
