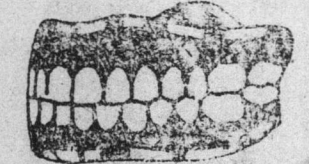

Upon the recommendation of the Board of Food Control, and under the provisions of the War Measures Act, His Excellency the Administrator in Council has been pleased to order:—

1. That the export of Molasses from this Colony be prohibited until further notice.
2. That the export of Butterine and Oleo Margarine from this Colony be prohibited, except to St. Pierre, Miquelon, and in regard to the latter, that permission to export be restricted to the quantity required for consumption within the French Islands, under Regulations to be framed for that purpose by the Minister of Finance and Customs.

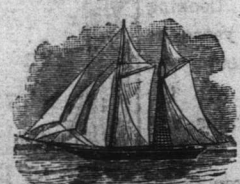
