The Meteorological service is controlled from the central office at Toronto. The staff at Toronto, on the latter service, numbers about 20, three of whom take magnetic observations also. Charles Carpunal is the director of the magnetic observatory at Toronto and superintendent of the meteorological service of the Dominion.
