**Regulations concerning delivery of Merchandise, payment of Freight, etc.**

When no express stipulation exists per Bill of Lading, goods are to be considered as deliverable on shore.

Freight on all goods to be paid, or secured to the satisfaction of the Captain or consignee of the vessel prior to the delivery of the goods.

After delivery to the purchaser of goods sold no claims for damage, deficiency or other cause, shall be admissible after goods sold and delivered have once left the city.

When Foreign Bills of Lading expressly stipulate that the freight shall be paid in a specific coin, then the same must be procured if required, or its equivalent given, the rate to be determined by the current value at the time at the Banks.
