HON. THOMAS MCGREEVEY, EX-M.P.

No public man has ever achieved a greater fame throughout the Dominion of Canada than Hon. Thomas McGreevey. His name is known in every section, and perhaps to every adult individual in the country. In the popular mind it is not associated with the formal parliamentary prefix "Hon.," but with the more familiar and affectionate title, "Uncle." This renown has come to Uncle Thomas by virtue of his being one of the most perfect products of our political system. He is a statesman of the pure Macdonald-Abbott-Mercier-Thompson-Haggart-Pacaud-Caron brand, the variety that Canada seems to appreciate, and which for the last twenty years she has specially honored. Mr. McGreevey has never done anything for the country (so far as we know). He sat in Parliament to represent his own pocket and the election fund of his party, and no man ever performed that mission with greater ability. He retired from Parliament last session, but his loss will not be greatly felt so long as statesmen of the same pattern remain to conduct our affairs.
