his conduct; but, on the contrary, was always ready and forward to lay all his measures before the public. He fpoke his mind freely on all occafions. He neither diffembled nor encouraged diffimulation; and yet he was of fuch unshaken fecrecy, that, during the whole of his administration, he gave no opportunity to the most willing of discovering his defigns to the enemy. In his hours of leifure he converfed with men of knowledge and experience : he fought information; and by it, together with his own unwearied affiduity and amazing penetration, he regulated the great machine of government; ever attached to the interests of the people and the honour of the crown. In a word, he was the fpirit of the war, the genius of England, and the comet of his age.
