

MR. WILLIAM ODELL, of Odell in Bedfordshire, England, name appears there in the probate of John, daughter Rebecca of obtaining further evidence of Odell, Odell, and Odell. The in the parish registers of Theodora, Odell, alias Odell, of Mollington, the progenitor of the Woodhulls in 1668.

Hezekiah Odell; issue, four children, Asaiah, Gershom, Bala and Anne; Gershom Odell had two children, William and Ruth. (Old Stratfield Church Records.)
