To all to whom these Presents shall come :- Greeting.

KNOW YE, that finding expedient and necessary to continue the Prohibition of the Distillation of Spirits, strong Waters and low Wines from any Wheat, Corn or other Grain, Meal or Flong within this Province; I do hereby, under the authority of the several Acts of the Parliament of this Province in force for that purpose, and by and with the advice and consent of his Majesty's Executive Council for the affairs of this Province, Probibit the Distillation of Spirits, strong Waters and low Wines from any Wheat, Corn, or other Grain, Meal or Flour within this Province, to the End of the next Session of Parliament, under the Penalties and Forfeitures by the said Acts imposed.

And I do for that purpose, iffue this my Proclamation, declaring the Provisions and Restrictions of the said acts, so far as they relate to the Distillation of Spirits, strong Waters are witness from wheat Corn, or other Grain, Meal or ar, with this province, to

be in force for the period over me ioned.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal at Arms, at kingston, this sixteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen, and in the fifty-fifth year of his Majesty's Reign.
