Whom he conveyed to them by the laying on of hands; that Spirit for the reception of Whom Christians are "builded together for an habitation of God, through the Spirit;" that Spirit Whose fruits are "love, joy, peace, long-suffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance."—Nothing less than this fulness of divine grace, wrought by the Holy Ghost in the hearts of the regenerate, will satisfy the earnest craving of the devout adult candidate; as nothing less will answer to the sure trust expressed on behalf of her children by the Universal Church.
