## T'ORONTO FREE LIBRARY.

RULES AND REGULATIONS,

As adopted Marcii 14, 1883.

1. The Board of Management shall elect one of their number as Chairman, who shall hold office for one year ; he shall preside at meciings of the Board when present; in his absence a Chairman may be ehosen pro tem. The Chairman shall have the same right of voting as other members of the Board, and no other.45 Vic. ch. 22, sec. 8.
2. The Board shall meet at least once every ealendar month, and at such other times as they may think fit.-lbid, sec. 9. Regular monthly meetings shall take place on the first Friday of cach month at 4.15 o'eloek p. mu. If a quorm be not present in fifteen mimes after the homr appointed for sneh meeting, the meeting shall not be held.
3. The Chairman or any two members may smmmon a special meeting of the Board by giving at least two days' notice in writing to eaeh member, specifying the prorpose for which the meeting is called.-Ibid, sec: 10.
4. No business shall be tramsacted at any general or special meeting mess four members are present.-Ibid, wec, 11. Nor at any spenial meeting nuless specified in the notice thereof. And no appropriation of money shall be made, or indebtedness inenred exceeding slon, withont the eonenrring votes of a majority of all the members of the Board.
5. All orters and proceedings of the Board shall be entered in books to be kept by them for that purpose, and shall be signed by the Chairman for the time being.-lbid, sec. 12.
6. The Offieers of the Boarl shall be the Chaiman, Librarian, lst Assistant Librarian (who shall also perform the duties of Secretary), and sneh Assistant Librarians as may be found necessary from time to time, all of whom, exeept the Chairman, shall hold ofice during pleasnre.
7. The Chairman shall be cleeted at the first meeting in the month of February in each year. It shall be his duty to sign all vonehers approved by the Board, and all drafts which shall be drawn npon the City Treasnrer on aecount of the Library Fund ; to nominate the Standing Committees for the year, sneh nominations to be afterwards snbmitted for the approval of the Board; to prepare for the consideration of the Board the Annnal Report ; and to exereise a general snpervision over the affairs of the institntion.
8. There shall be three Standing Committees, viz. : a Committee on Buildings and Gronnds ; a Committee on Finance ; and a Committee on the Library and Reading Roons. Eael Committee to consist of fonr members, of whom three shall form a quorum. The Chairman of the Board shall be ex officio a member of all Committees.
9. The order of bnsiness at all regnlar meetings of the Board shall be as follows :-

13. Reports of the Librarian.
