NEW YORK, July 18.—(Special.)—Toronto Vampire cricketers played a draw game with the Crescent Athletic Club team to-day on the Bay Ridge grounds. The weather was excellent, and the groundskeeper furnished the play with a splendid wicket, which favored batters and puzzled the bowlers on both sides.
