Wheat in the Northwest. It is now found that there are approximately 2,600,000 bushels of wheat in country elevators in the Northwest, against 9,780,000 bushels a year ago, says 'The Minneapolis Market Record. It is probable that there are yet remaining in farmers' hands in the Northwest, for sale to country elevators, about 6,000,000 bushels, making, with the amount already in country
