Canadian Pacines constituted the feature among Canadian securities to-day. On London selling they declined two clear points on that beard. On the Toronto Exchange the stock sold down to 70%, closing at 80% bid, or 1% points lower than resterday's close. At Montreal the issue sold down to 80, closing at 80% bid. The sharp decline to-day was due to yesterday's adverse decision of the Chicago arbitrators to the effect that the road is not entitled to any differential over American roads on freight to and from Pacide coast points in the United States. Another cause for the weakness of C. P. R. is found in the, fact that earnings do not compare with the very heavy earnings of last fall, when the crop began to move early. Investors point to the unusually large harvests in Western Canada, and they believe that when the crop once begins to move earnings will largely increase and the stock will recover. War Eagle declined a couple of politicagain to-day, and other issues showed sympathetic easiness. Dominion Bank declared a semi-annual dividend of 5 per cent., payable Dec. 1.

The tightening European money markets and the complications with France caused Loudon to sell American rails to-day, but in spite of this the Wall-street market exhibited a much better tone than for some time past. The easy money situation and generally good railway and industrial outlook were the strengthering elements.
