London, Feb. 12.-Hon, Cecil Rhodes has resolved not to take his Cape-to-Cairo Railresolved not to take his Cape-to-Cairo Rall-way through German territory, but through the Congo Free State, under a personal ar-rangement in the first instance with the King of the Belgians, an arrangement which Mr. Rhodes outlined during his visit to Brussels last week. 
