BRITISH RAILWAYS DEMAND IMMEDIATE SETTLEMENT OF ISSUE

The executive committee of the engineers and firemen today received from Sir Auckland Geddes, minister of reconstruction, a communication regretting it was impossible to arrange a meeting to consider the wage question.
