RESOLUTIONS PASSED BY GIBSON BAND, NOVEMBER 1st.

1. Moved by L. Strength seconded by A. Commandant that Frank Roads get a permit to saw logs, 50 M of hard wood on Lot 9, Concession 3.
Carried, Chief in favour.
2. Moved by A. Commandant, seconded by L. Strength that Peter Decaire get a permit to sell saw logs, about 50 M on Lot 10, Concession 3 for hard wood.
Carried, Chief in favour.
3. Moved by L. Strength, seconded by A. Commandant that Isaac News be granted a permit on Lot 10, Concession 5, to cut 10 M ft. and Lot 13, Concession 5, 25 M. ft.
Carried, Chief in favour.
4. Moved by A. Commandant, seconded by L. Strength that Tom Rennie get a permit to cut saw logs on Lot 5, Concession 3 (hard wood) also Lot 4, Concession 3, about 40 thousand feet.
Carried, Chief in favour.
5. Moved by L. Strength, seconded by A. Commandant that William Rennie Jr, get a permit to cut saw logs, Lot 13, Concession 3, about 25 thousand.
Carried, Chief in favour.
