True, our gifts do not go to the far off heathen land, but they do go for the preservation of this precious religion for our sons and daughters, our brothers and sisters, in the fair land of Manitoba, which, if desolated of her churches and missionaries would ere many years had rolled around become the scene of like deeds of cruelty and barbarism.
