**DOMESTIC AND FOREIGN TRADE** (Bank of Commerce Circular) Exports of field produce during October were valued at \$6,000,000, or \$31,000,000 more than those of October, 1919. Purchases by the United States of wheat alone amounted to \$7,000,000 bushels. In addition to this, during the first fifteen days of October the purchases of flour aggregated \$5,546 barrels, equivalent to 297,000 bushels of wheat. Exports of this nature are continuing to move across the border in a larger volume than in the past.

Chief factor in bringing the total value of domestic produce exported during that month to \$129,000,000, a total exceeded only once in the month of October, namely in 1917, when war munitions constituted a large proportion of exports. In the exports of wood and non-metallic minerals and their products there was also a substantial increase in course of export declines in the figures for animal products, or articles manufactured from metals.

If exports continue to be normal during the remaining months of the fiscal year ending March next, the current year's total will be considerably greater than that of the previous year. It imports continue, however, on the same scale as during the first seven months of the fiscal year, the adverse trade balance will be of serious proportions. For the seven month period in question the unfavorable balance is \$140,000,000, as compared with a favorable balance of \$140,000,000 for the corresponding period in 1919.

Domestic conditions which developed during the latter part of the year, which have so largely influenced the foreign trade, consumers generally expect a radical readjustment of the market. Towards the close of that month, however, there was a slight improvement, due to a freer movement of field crops.

**MANUFACTURING AND COMMERCE** (Bank of Commerce Circular) In the motor, leather and clothing trades, particularly, distress still prevails, and in others it has been necessary to reduce the working staff. As a whole, however, the output of factories and mines is being maintained on a scale that compares favorably with that of previous years. Labor displaced by changes in the urban centers is required for mining, lumber and agriculture. Pulp and paper mills are being expanded, and new ones are being constructed; responsible mining corporations are taking practical steps to develop coal fields and oil areas; the growing and manufacturing of flax fibre is being extended, and in the chemical industry there is a notable expansion.

The first boat to call at Buenos Aires direct from a Canadian port, according to a Brazilian correspondent of this bank, reached that port on 16th September last. This is an event worth noting in the expansion of our foreign trade and mercantile marine, and it is hoped that it will lead to a further development of commercial intercourse between Canada and Brazil. Under an arrangement with the Canadian Government Merchant Marine East, the first sailing on this route took place from North Sydney, C. B., in November, and calls will be made at the chief ports on the way. During the winter season nine vessels of the Canadian Merchant Marine will sail from St. John and twenty-four from Halifax. In all there will be twelve distinct services, the principle of which are the London, Liverpool and West India.
