Proceeded to the Election of a Moderator, when Mr. Ormiston moved, seconded by Mr. Baird:—

Mr. Kennedy having declined the nomination, Mr. Coutts moved, seconded by Mr. Pringle:—

That the Rev. Mr. Ormiston, of Hamilton, be elected Moderator.

Mr. Ormiston was unanimously chosen, and, having taken the Chair, addressed the Synod.

The Clerk presented a list of the business left unfinished from last Synod, as also a list of reports required to be made by Presbyteries and Committees.

The Rev. Mr. Logie, Clerk of the Presbytery of Huron, was added to the Committee of Bills and Overtures.

The Rev. Messrs. Baird and Caven were appointed a Committee to examine the Accounts of the Synod's Treasurer.
